





# SPOT

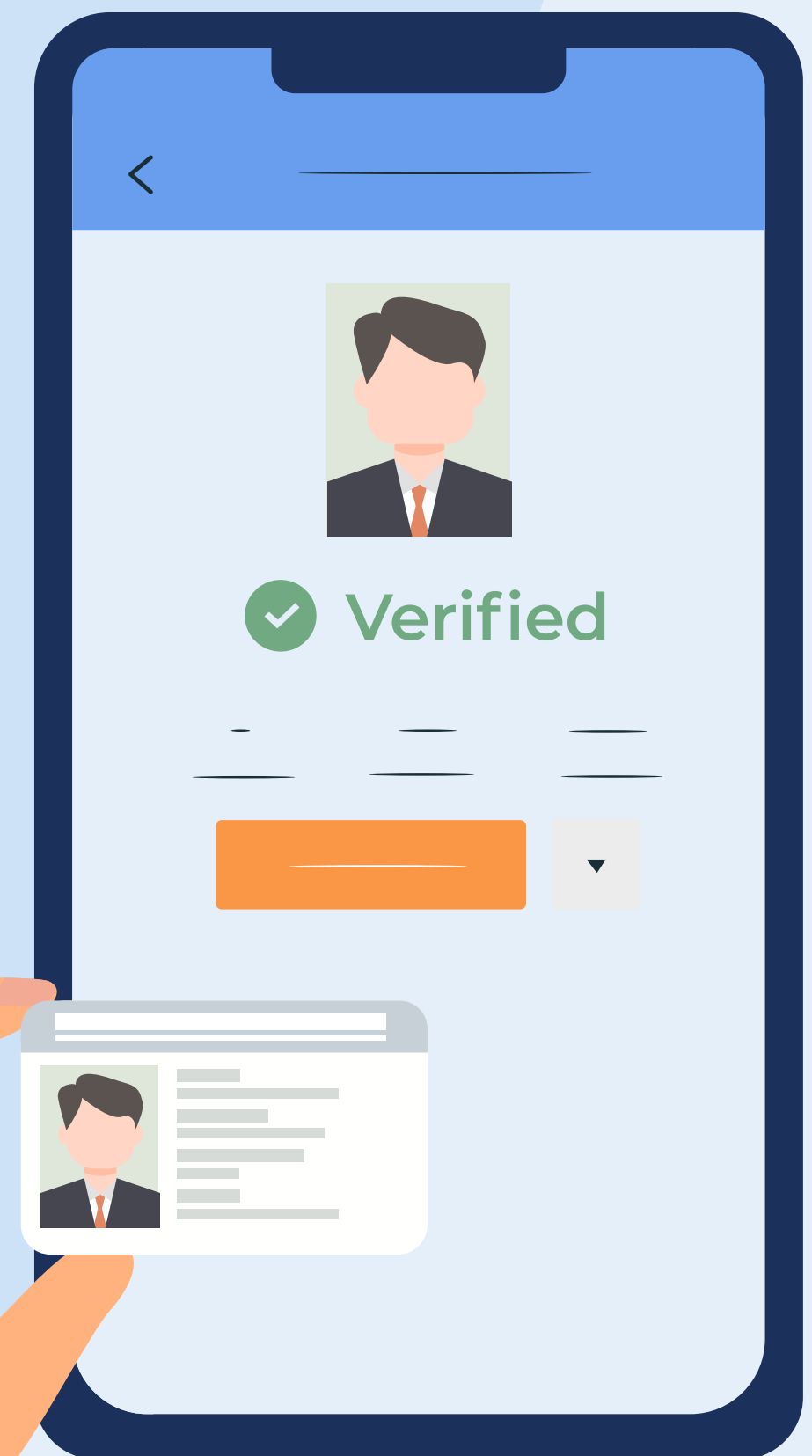
- Is the job too good to be true?
- Is the sender asking for money?
- Is the sender using an email ending with @gmail.com/ @hotmail.com?
- Did the sender provide you with their agency's license number and CEI number?





# CHECK

- Check if the sender's CEI number and name are listed in the Ministry of Manpower's EA Directory.
- Check if the job is advertised on the recruitment agency/hiring company's website.





# C**ONTACT**

- Get the recruitment agency/hiring company's contact details from the official corporate website.
- Call or email the recruitment agency/hiring company directly to verify if the job advertisement is legitimate.
